Dr. Steven A. Freeman is an associate professor of agricultural engineering at Iowa State University where he teaches undergraduate and graduate courses in occupational safety and graduate courses in curriculum development. He received his undergraduate degree in agricultural engineering from Colorado State University, his M.S. from Texas A&M University, and Ph.D. from Purdue University. Since 2004, he has also served as assistant director of Iowa State University's Center for Excellence in Learning and Teaching where he devotes 50% of his time to faculty development and coordinate scholarship of teaching and learning efforts on campus. His research interests include youth agricultural safety, workplace stress, risk perceptions, and safety decision making. He is also involved in researching student outcomes in technology and engineering curricula.
