Keith Krumpe is a professor and chair of the chemistry department at the University of North Carolina at Asheville (UNCA). He is originally from Pittsburgh, PA and received a BS in chemistry from Allegheny College in 1985. After completing a Ph.D. in organic chemistry at Emory University in 1991, Keith completed a post-doctoral research fellowship at the University of Pittsburgh before going to UNCA in 1992.

Keith is actively engaged in undergraduate research that focuses on the synthesis of biologically active molecules and the development of new synthetic methodologies. He has also served on the editorial staff of the NCUR Proceedings for over 10 years and currently serves as the Onsite Editor at each conference. Keith is also actively engaged with SENCER as a Summer Institute Faculty Member, as a Senior Associate, and as a co-Director of the newly formed SENCER Center of Innovation – South at UNCA.
