Biosketch

Matthew Laposata is an Associate Professor of Environmental Science at Kennesaw State University (KSU) in suburban Atlanta. He is the course coordinator for the two-semester General Education sequence “Science, Society, and the Environment” that enrolls approximately 6,000 students a year and teaches exclusively within the sequence. He has been actively involved with the SENCER project since 2000.

He has worked extensively in the scholarship of teaching and learning, with an emphasis on projects that utilize digital technologies to enhance instruction in introductory environmental science courses and in courses for future elementary school teachers. Notable projects include the NSF-sponsored “ESA21: Environmental Science Activities for the 21st Century” (<http://esa21.kennesaw.edu>) and the Technology-Enhanced Activity Modules for Science” projects (<http://teams.kennesaw.edu>). His scholarship has led to several University awards and he was selected as a recipient of the 2008 Scholarship of Teaching and Learning Award from the Georgia Board of Regents.
