Suzanne Larson has been a faculty member at Loyola Marymount University since 1986. She has taught a wide variety of courses and co-developed several new courses, including the freshman Mathematics Workshop that focuses on problem solving, mathematical communication and community building, a quantitative literacy course that involves students in projects relating to community issues, and an introductory probability and statistics course for mathematics majors. Support for these three development projects was received through SENCER and the Los Angeles Collaborative for Teacher Excellence. Dr. Larson has experience in working with Expanding Your Horizons programs that target underrepresented female students in mathematics and science. Currently, she serves as the Coordinator for the Mathematics Core Courses at Loyola Marymount University and is also a past chair of the Southern California Section of the Mathematical Association of America. She continues to be an active researcher in lattice ordered algebraic structures.
